- 2w 1920s Hat & Knox Hat Box: hat has flowers & berries, does have some damage to berries, lining possibly replaced; hat box has fox hunt scene, shows some wear
- 3w Plaster Cheetah Sculpture: has the feeling of fur, green painted eyes, painted collar, heavy
- 4w Fur Hat & Stoles: mink hat, Mr. Karl tag, mink stole, w/feet & eyes; + hat box
