- 1a WWII USMC Campaign Hat: USMC hat cord, USMC hat device, stamped "Hat, Service, Field 1944" in hat band, named on inside, hat band has some minor wear
- 2a Jim Beam Stone Mountain Decanter: "Monument to the South", made by Regal China, 1974
- 3a (2) Unit Histories: "The Thunderbolt Across Europe, A History of the 83rd Infantry Division, 1942-1945"; "The United States Army Training Center, Armor, Co. B-5th Bn. 1957"
- 4a (3) WWI Books & Postcard: "The Story of Europe and the Nations at War", copyright 1914; "Pictorial History of the World War for Liberty", copyright 1919; "New Pictorial History of the World War for Human Rights", copyright 1919, some pages are loose from spine; RPPC of (2) US soldiers wearing engineer collar disks
- 5a (2) Books: "Heroes of Three Wars", 1879; "Fiftieth Anniversary of the Battle of Gettysburg" revised edition April 1915, spine it taped
- 6a Photos & Documents: framed photo of USS Pennsylvania; official US Navy photo, 1974, description reads "Pacific Ocean... A Soviet 'Kanin' class guided missile destroyer underway in Hawaiian Waters.", photo has a small tear at top and some creasing at right corner; US Army Transportation School certificate, Private Ira C. Grove, Jr., US 52439232, June 4th, 1957; USMC discharge (COPY) Harold A. Brown, Corporal, June 11, 1919
- 7a WWII USMC Pith Helmet: stamped International Hat Co., 1943, small eagle, globe and anchor on front, hat band and hat have wear
- 8a Civil War Newspaper & Photos: Frank Leslie's Illustrated Newspaper, New York May 28, 1864, does have condition issues due to the age of the paper; photo (COPY) of Chambersburg PA, Aug. 1864; (2) cabinet cards, one of young man wearing SVA uniform, other of older man, possible Civil War veteran?
- 9a 19th Century US Shako: musician cap badge, red pom-pom, no lining on inside, leather band on inside and around back edge is loose
- 10a Reenactor Spurs: machine made, has some rust
- 11a M1840 Horstmann Marine Corps NCO Sword: early wide blade, marked Horstmann Philadelphia, not dated, blade measures approx. 31.5" long, scabbard is rough, it is torn in half but both pieces are there
- 12a WWII Book & Photos: "100 Best True Stories of World War II", copyright 1945, spine is loose; (3) photos, (2) of the Japanese surrender, (1) of concentration camp (at least 2 of the photos are COPIES)
- 13a USMC Spiked Helmet: stamped on inside of leather band "Wm. H. Horstmann Co. Philadelphia, Mar. 4 1899", nice condition
- 14a (3) WWII Newspapers: Times Herald, Washington D.C., Monday, August 6, 1945, headline "World's Deadliest Bomb Hits Japan for First Time; Equals 20,000 Tons of TNT"; Times Herald, Washington D.C., Tuesday, May 8, 1945, headline "Truman Proclaims VE-Day"; Times Herald, Washington D.C., Wednesday, November 6, 1940, headline "Roosevelt Wins!"; The Alexandria Gazette, Alexandria VA, Friday, April 13, 1945, headline "Nation Mourns Departed Leader" (all papers have condition issues, tears, stains, etc.)
- 15a Assorted Lot: USMC sleeve rank; tin type of Civil War soldier in Union case; tin type of boy, in case; uniform buttons; insignia; bullets; etc.
- 16a Military Ephemera: Basic Field Manual-Soldier's Handbook, 1941; photos; assorted WWII paperwork, mostly Army Air Forces; etc.
- 17a WWII German Helmet: double decal, original liner & chin strap, liner shows wear/cracking, helmet has a few rust spots (we are not military experts, we do not guarantee the authenticity of these items, everything sold as is)
- 18a Soldier Toys: (3) metal WWI soldiers, one helmet is detached; (4) WWI soldiers, Elastolin Germany; Marx WWII German soldier
- 19a WWII German Armband, Pins, etc.: WWII German armband, has some fading; WWII German Wehrmacht Frankfurt-Main matchbox holder, marked Ges. Gesch on back; WWII German Tank Assault stick/lapel pin; WWII German party pin (we are not military experts, we cannot guarantee the authenticity of these items, everything sold as is)
- 20a Military Bayonet: with scabbard, no markings, scabbard shows wear
- 21a (2) WWII German Pins: WWII German NS-RKB Member's breast eagle, marked "2 Ges. Gesch" on back; WWII German Close Combat pin, missing pin on back, marked "FEC. W.E. Peekhaus Berlin" & "AUS F.C.F. Juncker Berlin" on back (we are not military experts, we do not guarantee the authenticity of these items, everything sold as is)
- 22a (3) WWII German Pins: WWII German wound badge, w/black finish; WWII German SA Sports badge, bronze, marked on back "Eigentum D.S.A. Sportarz - Hauptstella, E. Schneider" number 348910, has some rust on back where clasp is attached; WWII German Coastal Artillery badge, "Otto Placzek Berlin, C.E. Juncker Berlin", missing pin on back (we are not military experts, we do not guarantee the authenticity of these items, everything sold as is)
- 23a Books & Magazine: "History and Manual of the Army Nurse Corps" The Army Medical Bulletin, Number 41, Oct. 1, 1937, cover has some damage; "Fighting Yanks Around the World", copyright 1943; Life Magazine, June 29, 1942
- 24a Pins & Medals: Purple Heart medal, ribbon, pin, in original box; United States Navy Commendation medal, ribbon, pin, in original box; Legion of Merit medal w/oak leaf cluster, ribbon, in original box; Army Good Conduct medal; Army of Occupation ribbon, missing medal; (4) US Army Marksman badge, some with machine gun tab
- 25a WWI USMC Uniform: tunic w/marksman pin, World War I Victory medal w/France clasp & Maltese cross, World War I Victory ribbon w/bronze

campaign star, service stripes on sleeve, 5th Marine shoulder sleeve patch, USMC collar disks, some buttons detached (they are in the front pocket), has some moth holes throughout; pants are stamped in the waistband "Quartermaster Corps U.S. Marine Corps 1918-19?", there are moth holes throughout, one larger hole in the back of leg, pair wool puttees; overseas cap, w/USMC cap device on one side, "13" on other side, nothing throughout, wear to inside

- 26a WWI USMC Helmet: has liner and chin strap, helmet number stamped at back ZC40, chin strap has number 7 stamped on it, last name on chin strap, USMC cap device on front, helmet shows some wear
- 27a WWI Gas Mask & Bag: gas mask is brittle and has interior cracking, glass is still intact, w/anti-dimming stick, envelope containing instructions, record card, tape for repairs, safety pin for adjusting harness; name written on inside of bag
- 28a WWI USMC Overcoat: service stripes on sleeve, some small moth holes
- 29a (3) Civil War Books: "Battles and Leaders of the Civil War", with dust jacket; "Gardner's Photographic Sketch Book of the Civil War"; "A Pictorial History of the Confederacy"
- 30a USMC Dress Blues: jacket, no collar insignia, and pants
- 31a USMC Dress Blue Hat: w/ USMC cap device, Jacob-Reed's & Sons, Philadelphia
- 32a USMC Dress Blues: jacket w/Expert Rifleman badge, no collar insignia, pants
- 33a USMC Dress Blue Hat: w/ USMC cap device
- 34a USMC Dress Blues: jacket, w/collar insignia, pants
