- 3c John Bell Crock: glazed redware, roughness to the glazing on rim
- 4c Stoneware Crock: doubled handled, blue decorated, chips on rim, chips on handles, chips on base
- 5c F. H. Cowden Harrisburg PA Crock: chip on rim
- 6c Beaumont Pottery York Maine: 1998, blue decorated, signed on bottom jar w/lid
- 7c J. Sykes & Co. Demijohn: 117 Dale Street Liverpool Rail
- 8c Blue Decorated Pitcher: modern
- 9c Hawthorn Pottery Co. Crock: Hawthorn PA 1 gallon
- 10c Large Stoneware Crockery Jar: no name, small chip on base
- 11c Beaumont Pottery York Maine: blue decorated, bowl
- 12c John Bell Jug: Waynesboro
- 13c Blue Decorated Crock: 1 gal., floral band, some chipping out of glazing, chip around top rim
- 14c 2 Gallon Kings Crown Crock: hairline crack w/ non-matching lid
- 15c W. Sherringham Fakenham Jug: 1203 2 gallon, brown white
- 16c 3 Gallon Jug: blue decorated, tobacco spit
- 17c 3 Gallon Jug: blue decorated, hairline crack at base
- 18c Pioneer Pottery New Bethlehem PA: 9s 3 Gallon jug, brown, white, chip at spout
- 19c Large 3 Gallon Crock: blue decorated 3 in blue wreath, small chip around rim
